

This poor dog had suffered from severe neglect. In addition to his dirty and horribly matted fur, our vet discovered that his teeth were in such bad shape that 12 extractions were required. It's no wonder this brave little guy had so much trouble eating. Little Bruno had another infection from a wound, and we are happy to report that he has healed completely. He is afraid of other dogs, and is shy around people until he gets to know you. Then his gentle, loving spirit shines thru. Our vet believes this determined little senior is about 12 years old.
